Florida State Law 327.395 Boating Safety Identification Cards



In order to operate a motorboat of ten (10) horsepower or greater, *Florida law (P.L. 327.395)* requires anyone who was born on or after Jan. 1, 1988 to successfully complete an *approved boating safety course* and obtain a Boating Safety Education Identification Card issued by the FWC.



Florida does not have a "boating license." The Boating Safety Education Identification Card is proof of successful completion of the educational requirements and is valid for life.

29,359 Cards issued state-wide in calendar year 2012.



Visitors can get a temporary certificate in order to rent a boat or PWC.








May be obtained directly through USCG or a USCG-Approved Captain's License Course (Sea School)

USCG-NMC approved vendor in *Monroe County*:

<u>Captains Marine</u> • Based in the Florida Keys and is approved by the United States Coast Guard and National Maritime Center to conduct classroom and online courses for the following: OUPV; 50-100 Ton Masters; Tow, Sail, & Marine Radio Operator Endorsements

Monroe County Boater Education Statistics



- Total Registered Recreational Vessels: 23,863
- Boater Safety I.D. Cards issued: 355 (Source: FWC, 2012)
 - Completed USCG Auxiliary BS&S Class: ~700 (Source: USCG Auxiliary, 2012)
 - Completed USPS ABC Boater Course: ~100 (Source: USPS, 2012)
 - Online Boating Course completion accounts for 60% of Boater Safety I.D. cards issued state-wide (all counties +/- 5%)
- FKNMS partners with USCG Auxiliary and USPS by providing education staff to give a 1-hour guest lecture specific to sanctuary regulations and resource protection as related to boating during most classes held in Monroe County
